Sub: Aarogyasri Health Care Trust – Notice issued by Telangana Aarogyasri Outsourcing Employees Association to go on strike from the midnight of 24-07-2015 – Alternate arrangements made – Intimation - Regarding.

Ref: Strike notice dated 02.07.2015 issued by Telangana Aarogyasri Outsourcing Employee Association. (Addressed to CEO AHCT and copy marked to Principal Secretary to Govt., HM & FW Dept. Govt. of Telangana).

It is to bring to your kind notice that the 'Telangana Aarogyasri Outsourcing Employee Association', vide reference cited (copy enclosed) have issued a notice to go on strike from the midnight of 24-07-2015, if the demands put forth by them are not met before that date. The Trust has reported the matter to Government vide letter No. 91 /F25/2015 dated 07-07-2015 furnishing remarks on each of the demands. Besides that, the Chief Executive Officer, Aarogyasri Health Care Trust held discussions with the representatives of the Association on 22-07-2015 and assured them that their demands relating to conversion as 'contract employees', enhancement of remuneration, sanction of increments, giving seniority based promotions, sanction of leave / availment of holidays on par with Government employees, which involve policy decisions, will be referred to Government / placed before the Board of Trustees for their consideration and decision, and all efforts were made to dissuade them from going on strike. In spite of that, the Association declared to go on strike from the midnight of 24-07-2015 as appeared in the daily news papers dated 23-07-2015.

2. In this regard, it is bring to your kind notice that the Trust is making alternate arrangements to see that the services to Aarogyasri / Employees Health Scheme (EHS) patients go uninterrupted by giving 'logins' to the MEDCOs of the network hospitals. As the MEDCOs will be registering the patients and raising preauthorizations, no inconvenience will be caused to the Aarogyasri / Employees Health Scheme (EHS) patients, even if the outsourced Field Staff go on strike. Action is also being taken to issue a press notification to the above extent for the information of the beneficiaries.
